## Associate (Cooperating) Membership

Associate(cooperating) membership of the EA is primarily a spiritual level engagement. It manifests the spiritual connection and expresses willingness to:

- Be connected to the Medical Section
- Participate in the January meeting of training course directors
- Share research questions with colleagues
- Help develop Anthroposophical Art Therapy
- Discuss and share organisational and curriculum issues with other schools/colleges
- Engage in discussions to support the accreditation process

Associate (cooperating) membership does **not** mean

- The training is recognized according to the EA criteria. Nor is the training course of an Associate (Cooperating) Member recognized by the Medical Section. Recognition of a training comes with full membership of the EA after it has successfully completed the accreditation process.  
Associate (Cooperating) membership of the EA can be promoted on websites etc. Statements on the training brochure however should under no circumstances imply that its associate (cooperating) membership of the EA leads to the recognized qualification of Anthroposophic Arts Therapist.

The EA will produce a membership card which states that:

The anthroposophic art therapy training (name) has joined the European Academy for Anthroposophical Art Therapy as an Associate (Cooperating) Member. It accepts the EA guidelines for art therapy training. Its association with the EA means that it works together with the Medical Section of the School of Spiritual Science at the Goetheanum.
