

Associative Membership

The membership as an associate member in the EA is mainly in the sphere of free spiritual life. It expresses the spiritual connection and contains:

- The will to be connected with the medical section
- The presence during the January conference of the heads of training
 - The exchange with colleagues about approaches of research
 - The development of anthroposophic art therapies
 - Arrangement with other trainings about curricular questions
 - Mutual support during the accreditation process

The membership does **not** contain

- The recognition of a training according to the EA criterions. That means: the training is not an accredited member of the EA, because it does not work according to the EA standards yet and it is still not recognized by the Medical Section. The cooperative membership in the EA can be mentioned on a website. In no way may the certificates of training say/tell that the cooperative membership in the EA leads to the recognized title of an anthroposophic art therapist.

You will get a document on which is written:

The school for anthroposophic art therapy is connected as associate training to the European Academy for Anthroposophic Art Therapy. It uses the guidelines of the EA in the education for the art therapist. Therefore it works together with the Medical Section of the School of Spiritual Science at the Goetheanum.

Heads of training can become associate members.
