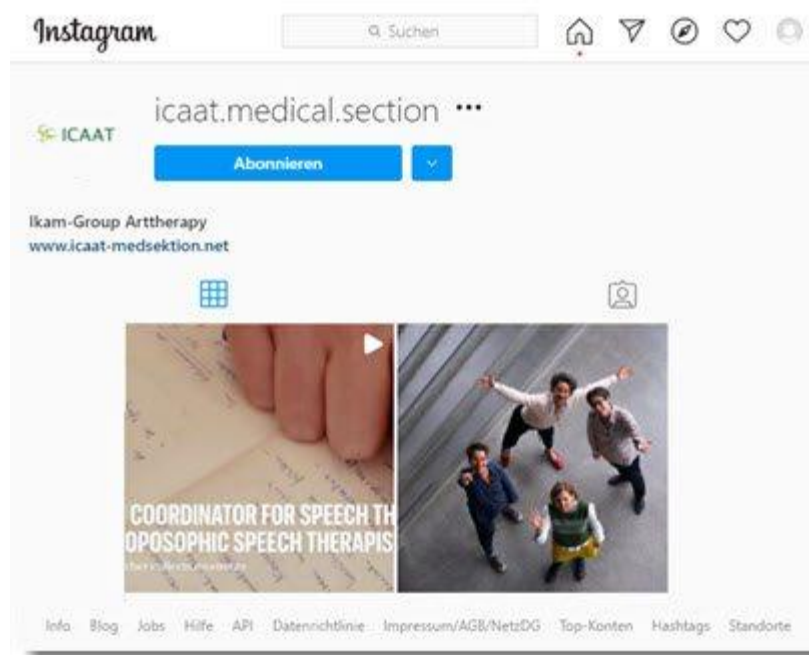
### ICAAT on Instagram

The next Studying Days for Anthroposophic Arts Therapy from 06-8.01.2022 are in preparation. For the 24th time in a row, all our departments will be experienced in their full range. For the first time as a team of art therapists and doctors we have the pleasure to organize this international meeting together.

It can be clearly experienced that our society is dealing with the idea of health and disease more publicly than ever before worldwide. Epidemiological topics such as vaccination or incidences dominate the public news. Medicine, therapy and culture have come into focus all over the planet. However, the focus of news coverage has been more on the pathological than the salutogenetic aspect of life.

Art and culture, on the entire, were classified as having so little relevance to the system or worthy of support that we - as art therapists - were left almost speechless. It became clear to us that the next Studying Days for Anthroposophical Art Therapy should deal very specifically with the healing aspect of art as medicine.

For 2022, therefore, we would like to create a framework in which Anthroposophical Medicine and Art Therapy will focus more on the alchemy of art - the aesthetics of healing substance.

For those people who will not be able to travel, we are in preliminary consideration of an online session of the conference that can be broadcast afterwards. The program will be posted here as soon as it is ready.

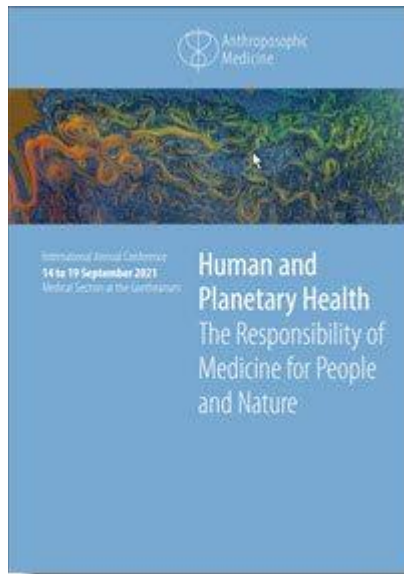
**The responsibility of medicine for humanity and nature**
